## Group Leader Notes 2.12.17

Sermon Title: "Abundance: Prophetically Positioned" - Dr. David Speicher

**Ice Breaker**: What was the first car you ever owned/drove? What do you remember about it?



**Song Suggestions:** "All Because of Jesus" by Matt Maher, "Your Love Never Fails" by Jesus Culture, "Enough" by Chris Tomlin, "Hosanna" by Hillsong United, "Faithful to the End" by Cory Asbury

**Read Scripture**: John 10:10, John 8:21-30, Psalm 46:10

**Q** 1: What comes to mind when you hear the word abundance in *John 10:10*?

**Q 2:** Pastor Speicher mentioned three things we must believe in order to walk in the abundant life that God has for us...what were they? (*Follow up question if needed...Do you believe God speaks today? Why or why not?*)



**Q** 3: What are some obstacles to tuning into God's frequency and hearing His voice?

(Group leader: Don't be afraid to be transparent with your group here. Share a specific story of struggle, doubt, etc. Share how God did or how God is speaking into those doubts and struggles.)

**Q 4:** Break off into groups of 3-4 and spend some time listening for the voice of God together. Remember the instructions of Psalm 46:10, "Be still...be quiet, listen. Ask: "Father, what do you want me to hear?"

(Group leader: This may be a perfect time to play a worship song to set up the posture of worship and then have a time of silent listening. Filter every word spoken through group members through the written word of God. He will never contradict what He's already given. This time should be a time to confirm in the hearts of those present that God does indeed speak, and speak to them! This time is meant to be encouraging and uplifting...don't rush through, but allow yourself to linger in His presence. Be encouraged, you are loved!)



## **Group Leader:**

Spend some time dwelling and asking our heavenly Father how we can take action to meet the felt needs of the world and show our love. Listen to His answers! Make a SAM goal. (*Specific, Attainable, Measureable*) and share it with 1-2 people. Ask them to lovingly check in on your progress on that goal during the week. As a group, pray over those "neighbors" that have been laid on your heart. Now go do it!

Also, don't forget about the Send Challenge. Although the official time period for the competition is done, keep going! Some challenges can be done individually, some as a Group, so keep living a lifestyle of Send as we all seek to impact the world for the Kingdom of God! Remember, we at South Bay believe that the Christian living the abundant life that Christ has for them is living a life of Caring, Equipping, and Sending!
