Sermon Title: – **“The Pursuit”**: Week 3 - Dr. David Speicher

Ice Breaker: If you could invite three people (living or dead) to a dinner party, who would it be?



Song Suggestions: “*Everlasting God*” by Brenton Brown, “*Chasing*” Charlie Hall, “*Scandal of Grace*” by Hillsong United, “*One thing Remains*” by Bethel Worship, “*You won’t Relent*” by Misty Edwards

Read Scripture: *John 4:1-42, John 3:17, Galatians 5:22-23*

Q 1: What stands out or strikes you as significant from the story of the woman at the well in John 4?

Q 2: What are the three impacts of the Holy Spirit mentioned by Pastor Speicher?
(1. *Awareness of the Holy Spirit in your life* 2. *The fruit of the Spirit* 3. *The gifts of the Spirit*)

Q 3: Why is the order important/significant?

Q 4: Do a little self-reflection here...ask this question of the Lord, “am I aware of the Holy Spirit in my life?” (where is He speaking, moving, etc.)

Q 5: Pastor Speicher likened our lives and our interaction with the Holy Spirit like a sail from a ship, with the Holy Spirit being the wind...ask the Lord... “is anything hindering your sail from being open to the wind of the Spirit?”



Group Leader:

Spend some time dwelling and asking our heavenly Father how we can take action to meet the felt needs of the world and show our love. Listen to His answers! Make a SAM goal. (*Specific, Attainable, Measureable*) and share it with 1-2 people in your group. Ask them to lovingly check in on your progress on that goal during the week this week. As a group, pray over those “neighbors” that have been laid on your heart. Now go do it!

Also, don't forget about the Send Challenge. Although the official time period for the competition is done, keep going! Some challenges can be done individually, some as a Care Group, so keep living a lifestyle of Send as we all seek to impact the world for the Kingdom of God! Remember, we at South Bay believe that the Christian living the abundant life that Christ has for them is living a life of Caring, Equipping, and Sending!
