Ice Breaker: What is your favorite movie quote?

Read Scripture: *John 10:10, Galatians 6:2, 2 Timothy 2:15, John 20:21*

Q 1: What is the encouragement for believers found in *Galatians 6:2*? How does that comfort you?

Q 2: What four characteristics from *2 Timothy 2:15* did Pastor Speicher share about one who is equipped? (*Teachable, Obedient, Confident, Christ Centered*)



Q 3: What command for every believer do we see in *John 20:21*? What feelings does this directive stir in you?

Q 4: *John 10:10* speaks of the two plans for our lives...one from our enemy, and one from our Heavenly Father...interact with this statement made by Pastor Speicher. Agree? Disagree? Why? How have you this idea of abundance play out in your life?

Spend some time dwelling and asking our heavenly Father how we can take action to meet the felt needs of the world and show our love. Listen to His answers! Make a SAM goal. As a group, pray over those “neighbors” that have been laid on your heart. Now go do it!
