Sermon Title: – **“The Pursuit”**: Psalm 32 - Dr. David Speicher

Ice Breaker: If you found yourself facing the firing squad and you had to choose the last meal you would ever eat, what would it be?

Read Scripture: *Psalm 32, Psalm 139:23-24; Psalm 119:11; 105*

When it comes to sin, confession, and God’s cleansing forgiveness, sometimes we need to be reminded of the simple yet profound truths of God’s word. Take a few minutes to meditate quietly on the truth of 1 John 1:9. After a time of silence, read it multiple times emphasizing different words. (IF, CONFESS, HE, FAITHFUL, FORGIVE, CLEANSE, etc.)

Q 1: Read *Psalm 139:23-24*...ask the Lord in the quietness of your heart this question, “Lord, is there any offensive way in me that I need to confess to You?”

Q 2: In *Psalm 119:105*, God’s word is called a lamp to our feet, and a light to our path...now that you have allowed to the Lord to examine your heart condition, ask Him, Lord is there
